

Motor City Dolly DIY Bone Chair or Sofa Kit Instructions

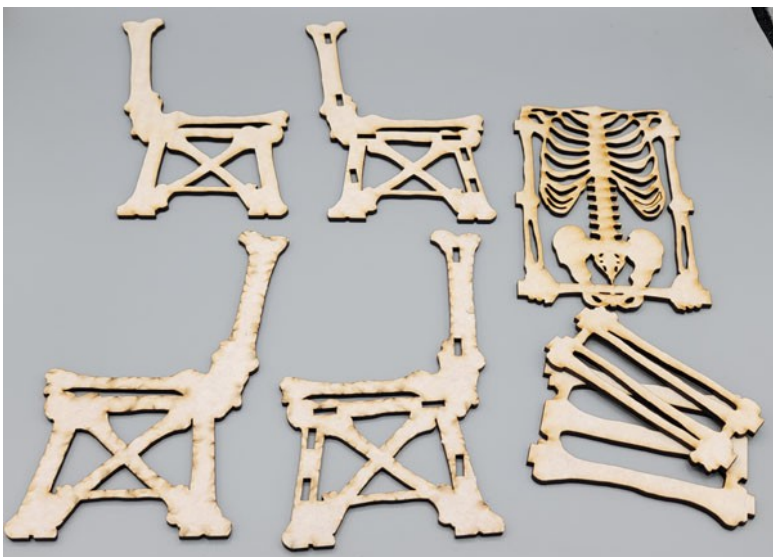
Thanks so much for purchasing this DIY kit to make your own 1/6 scale skelly chair or sofa (Assembly instructions are the same for either kit.) This chair/sofa is a unique design by Pete Coe. To complete your chair, you will also need:

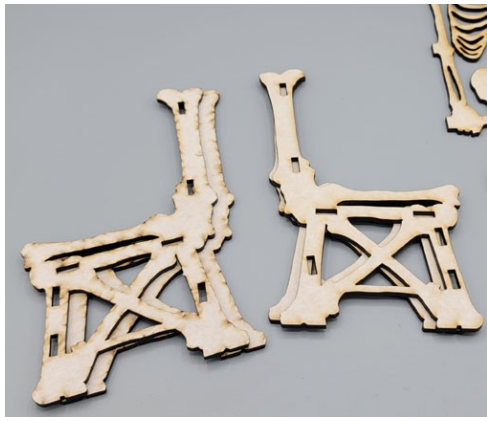
Wood Glue
Fine Sand Paper
Paint or other choice of finish
Rubber Bands
A Dremel can be helpful but not required

All of the pieces in your kit come with protective masking on both sides. Step one is to remove the masking on each piece, then give them a light sanding with fine grit sandpaper to remove any glue residue.



Your kit has four side pieces---the outer pieces do not have any notches, while the two identical inner pieces have slots for the other pieces to fit into. Glue an inner piece to each outer piece.





Once the sides have dried, glue the large back piece, the wider seat piece, and the smaller front piece into the slots of the side pieces



Then glue the other side piece on, matching tabs to slots.



Use rubber bands to hold the chair together while it dries.

Once the glue has dried, I like to use my Dremel and sand paper to round the edges and make the piece look more realistic.
